



2024 Junior Division Rules

- The quilt must be constructed when the entrant is 17 years of age or younger.
- The quilt must be constructed entirely by the entrant; no adult assistance with the physical work of creating the quilt is allowed but verbal assistance or instruction is allowed.
- The maximum quilt size is 36" x 36" or a perimeter of 144" (Perimeter in inches = Width + Width + Length + Length).
- A hanging sleeve may be attached to the quilt but is not required.
- If you have a personal label on the back side of your quilt, please cover it.
- The entered quilt must be clean and free of pet hair.
- Due to transfer issues with glitter embellishments on quilts, any quilt with attached glitter will be disqualified.
- Only one quilt is allowed per entrant.
- There is no registration fee for the Junior Division
- The completed quilt, the registration form, and a 4" x 6" photo must be mailed and received by the Quilt Show Registrar no later than July 1, 2024.
- Each Junior Division quilt will be judged by the quilt show's judge.
- First, second, and third place awards will be given in the Junior Division.
- Cash awards and the judges comment sheet can be picked up at Guest Services beginning on the first day of the show continuing through the end of the show. Provisions can be made to mail your cash award or judges comment sheet if you are unable to pick it up.
- All quilts that are not claimed will be taken to the Ozark Piecemakers Quilt Guild at 2738 S. Campbell Ave, Springfield, MO 65807. Quilts can be retrieved by appointment at this location.
- Each entry will be insured. A default value will be assigned based on size. If the entrant feels the assigned value is too low, an appraisal by a certified quilt appraiser must accompany the registration form. The default values are as follows:
 - \$500 for quilts 60" and greater on the shortest side.
 - \$250 for quilts less than 60" and greater than 24" on the shortest side.
 - \$150 for quilts 24" and smaller on the longest side.
